The Akillian Gallery, the Milton Art Museum, and the Alumni Exhibition Series all serve Massasoit students, faculty, staff and the community, through exhibitions of quality artwork. Each Holiday Season, the Akillian Gallery is host to the Prints and Pottery Sale, coupled with the annual Student's Printmaking Show. Each May, the Canton Campus hosts an Arts Festival, where visual arts students display work in a competitive, juried show. Other Arts Festival exhibitions include the Regional High School Show and the Open Juried Show, all with awards and prizes. The Ink Monkeys, an open printmaking group, meets regularly to explore, create and demonstrate printmaking methods and techniques. Massasoit printmaking students are frequently juried into the prestigious Arches Student Print Exhibition, presented in conjunction with the Boston Printmakers North American Print Biennial. The Visual Arts Department also maintains The Print Archive, a collection of student prints, donated upon graduation. Exhibition venues are free and open to the public.
