Three pounds Hydrocal FGR 95 plaster (see Portland Pottery)

One gallon plastic bucket

Two, 6 oz. plastic yogurt cups

One pound microcrystalline sculpting wax

Butter knife

Clamp light

60 watt bulb

Metal , one gallon pail

One, twenty-five pound box of course grade terra cotta clay (see Portland Pottery)

1/4 inch pottery wire (see Portland Pottery)
